CHRISTIAN THEMATIC APPROACH

We use monthly Christian themes to develop activities that are hands on, interactive, fun and meet the goal of our school in using biblical principles in character building.

INNOVATIVE PROGRAMS

Our programs are geared towards bringing up child to fit into the 4th industry revolution, incorporate critical thinking in our daily interaction with the learners by offering learning opportunities where the teacher is a facilitator and the learner given the chance to ask the “why” Children are allowed to engage in constant reflection and inquisition, Constant learning Connection and collaboration.



CREATIVITY

Children are encouraged to think creative by making them question things, we provide opportunities to express their intelligence, we teach them multiple ways to solve every problem, we trigger their curiosity, we engage them with activities, we encourage children to read for pleasure and give them free time & space.

MULTIPLE INTELLIGENCE APPROACH

The Multiple Intelligence (MI) is based on a belief that there exists a multitude of intelligences, quite independent of each other and that each intelligence has its own strengths and constraints. We incorporate all the 9 MI through tasks and activities in the classrooms. Multiple Intelligence Approach they include these learners; verbal / linguistic, logical / mathematical, visual / spatial musical / rhythmic, bodily / kinesthetic, naturalist, intrapersonal, interpersonal and existential. In our daily lessons we capture the three types of learners; the visual, the auditory and the kinesthetic.

DIFFERENTIATED LEARNING

Differentiated Learning is effective instruction that is responsive to students’ readiness, interests and learning preferences. This enables learners to build new learning through connections to existing knowledge and preferred ways of working with concepts, interests and learning preferences. Our Teachers use a repertoire of instructional and assessment strategies to meet the needs of different learners.

INDIVIDUALIZED ATTENTION

Our classrooms are supported by two teachers who work collaboratively to engage small groups and provide individualized attention. We incorporate tailored approach for struggling learners under our Olivine Learning Support Program (OLSP).



OLIVINE SCHOOL CURRICULUM

LITERACY

Literacy is the backbone of all core subjects, we ensure we incorporate all literacy components to align to the Kenyan Competence Based Curriculum (CBC). We use the British Jolly phonics and Jolly grammar literacy curriculum from Playgroup to Grade 6.

Our literacy components are:-

PHONOLOGICAL AND PHONEMIC AWARENESS WITH THE BRITISH JOLLY PHONICS CURRICULUM

Our phonics programme for teaching students' sounds, blends, speech in English is used throughout the school

INDIVIDUALIZED LEARNING SUPPORT (ILS)

Our ILS ensure a struggling student is assisted in the area of weakness, be it dyslexia, dyscalculia or dysgraphia by offering support. We use the Jolly phonics extra talking pen program for struggling readers.

GUIDED READING PROGRAM

Twice per week, students receive instructions in reading mechanism and comprehension using Guided Reading Programme. Each child is guided as per their reading fluency. We use the Jolly Readers, Harcourt Readers, Oxford Tree readers, Lady Birds Readers and Janet and John Readers. Book projects are implemented by the children.

READING

Each day, the teacher carry out the DEAR initiative to instil a reading

HANDWRITING

We teach the 4ps in the aspect of handwriting instruction, that is, pencil grasp, pencil formation, pencil legibility and pencil pacing. We ensure we incorporate activities to strengthen fine motor muscles, teach handwriting with different mediums, expose them to letter play and encourage correct pencil grip (tripod hold).

GRAMMAR AND SPELLING

We use the Jolly Phonics grammar books from kindergarten to Grade 6 and spelling programme.

WRITERS WORKSHOP

We incorporate writer's workshop lesson focused on building students skills in independent writing where they share their writing with others.

LITERACY CENTER

We have a literacy center filled with age appropriate books with different literacy activities including grammar, word work, computer based learning.

MATHEMATICS

Mathematics/Numeracy is fundamental at Olivine School academic model.

COGNITIVELY GUIDED INSTRUCTION

This approach allows students to solve word problems using a strategy of their choice, then explain their thinking to the class thus building problem solving skills and critical thinking.

MATHS CENTRE

We ensure students use blended (computer based) programs in the digital lab, engage in independent maths practice.

ENVIRONMENTAL STUDIES, CHRISTIAN RELIGIOUS EDUCATION AND CREATIVE ARTS

We have termly Christian themes which are taught to all students and teach CRE as a lesson as well as Environmental studies, Music, Home science, Social Studies, Creative arts, Science and at least once a month exploration Day for the

KISWAHILI

We teach Kiswahili as a lesson to our students.

PHYSICAL EDUCATION

It is imperative for students to have body movement lessons by focusing on psychomotor skills which are age appropriate.

STEAM (SCIENCE, TECHNOLOGY, ENGINEERING, ARTS AND MATHS)

We have a STEAM and digital lab where students are stimulated to enjoy solving problems and exploring the world through science, technology, engineering, arts and math (STEAM). There are fun, easy ways to introduce STEAM to students. STEAM learning can support children's early math development and many other important skills.
